Please remember to take with you:

1. Your bar coded ID book/card or your passport
2. Your medical aid details (if you are on medical aid)
3. Employee card; and practice card or receipt in the case of registered practitioners
4. A valid cell-phone number in order to ensure further communication directly from the Department of Health



Present yourself at the vaccination site from 19 July in all provinces
(except Western Cape who will open from 22 July and Limpopo on 23 July)

The time and place for your vaccination will be advised to you by your Programme Managers.

The Programme Managers will schedule all officials within their respective Branches to be vaccinated at sites closest to where officials reside or those determined by the Department.

Please delay your vaccination if:



- You have COVID-19 or are still within the 10 day recovery period.
- You were hospitalised due to COVID-19 within the last 28 days.
- You have had any vaccine (including the flu vaccine) within the past 14 days.
- You had your first COVID-19 vaccine dose within the last 42 days.
- You have been advised by a medical doctor not to get vaccinated
- You have had a severe or immediate allergic reaction (within four hours) to your first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine

At the site



a steward will check you in with your ID number or employee number and check you are at the correct site.

A queue marshal will undertake a general health status check to check if you have any COVID-19 symptoms.

Queue marshals

will assist you and show you where to go to wait for your turn to be vaccinated.

Remain in the queue until you are called on to hand in your completed form to complete your online registration.

If you are on a medical aid further verification will occur.



An Administrator

will check your completed form and confirm your cell phone number and any other details that need to be added to the system.

Once the checks are completed you will be directed to the queue for the vaccination booth to be assisted by a healthcare professional.



Your medical and health

status questionnaire will be assessed by the healthcare professional to confirm your suitability for vaccine administration.

When it is your turn to be vaccinated, your information will be verified by the healthcare professional.

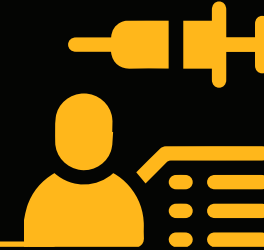


- The healthcare professional will seek your informed consent to administer the vaccine.
- The healthcare professional will follow the correct vaccine preparation and administer the vaccine dose.
- Vaccine administration details are recorded on your proof of vaccination card

The system is updated.

- You will be sent an SMS as soon as the system is updated.
- You will be directed to the post vaccine holding area.

You will follow a one-way path to a waiting area which adheres to social distancing



A Marshall

will observe you for any adverse reactions to the vaccine.

The waiting period is 15 minutes to see if you have any immediate reactions to the vaccine.

You will be provided with follow-up care information as well as your vaccine confirmation via SMS.

Single dose

If you are a recipient of the single dose vaccine, your journey is now complete. You will be provided with a vaccine proof code via SMS with instructions to save this code for future verification.

If you received the first dose of the double dose vaccine you will be sent information via SMS as to when you need to return for the second dose to complete your journey.
