Intent of SOP	To document the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for identification, capturing, storing and sharing of knowledge; allowing for re-use by other departmental employees. Also, for the creation and maintenance of a knowledge management portal where this knowledge will be made available.
Objective(s)	To provide integrated strategic direction and support to achieve good governance at all times
Scope	This SOP applies to all Departmental employees as each employee plays a vital role in the sharing of knowledge, generating new knowledge as well as acquiring knowledge.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Information – collection of raw facts from which conclusions can be drawn. ➤ Knowledge – Information that is contextual, relevant and useful to undertake action to solve a particular problem. ➤ Knowledge Management – process of capturing and documenting an individual's knowledge and then sharing that knowledge within the organization and effectively using it in order to enhance the organization's performance, productivity and effectiveness, also to increase the organization's competitive advantage. ➤ Tact knowledge – knowledge that is personal, not easy to express and difficult to communicate to others, the person may not even be aware they have that knowledge. ➤ Explicit knowledge – knowledge that is formal and codified. Can be easily communicated and shared because it has been documented. ➤ Knowledge champions – people appointed by the department to promote, support and communicate knowledge management initiatives within the department.
