- 10.2 If a bidder finds or reasonably believes it has found any discrepancy, ambiguity, error or inconsistency in the RFQ or any other information provided by the Department (other than minor clerical matters), the bidder must promptly notify Department in writing of such discrepancy, ambiguity, error or inconsistency in order to afford the Department an opportunity to consider what corrective action is necessary
