3. DELIVERY PERIOD

The washing machines must be delivered to the address of institution stated above in Nelson Mandela Metro within six weeks after the receipt of an official order.

4. PRICING

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- Service Providers must provide pricing for supply, installation and configuration of Three Heavy
 Duty Washing Machines in the attached pricing schedule (Annexure A).
- Prices must be inclusive of VAT. If not confirmed, the Department will assume that the price
